

# TIPS FOR DRIVING IN ABNORMAL WEATHER CONDITIONS



Driving condition:

## FOG

Risk:

- ⚠️ Visibility is reduced
- ⚠️ Other drivers' visibility is reduced

Tips:

- ✓ Don't drive in fog
- ✓ If you encounter fog on a journey, slow down, turn on front and rear fog lights and pull over at a safe location
- ✓ Be aware – other drivers may not see you
- ✓ Use the horn if necessary



Driving condition:

## RAIN

Risk:

- ⚠️ Visibility is reduced
- ⚠️ Aquaplaning (tyres not making contact with the road)
- ⚠️ Stopping distance increases
- ⚠️ Wadis forming

Tips:

- ✓ Slow down
- ✓ Turn on your headlights
- ✓ Keep safe space between you and the vehicle ahead (minimum 6 seconds)
- ✓ Never enter a flowing wadi
- ✓ If visibility is poor, pull over at a safe location until the visibility improves
- ✓ Before a journey, check your tyres & wiper blades

Driving condition:

## WIND

Risk:

- ⚠️ Dust
- ⚠️ Sand accumulation
- ⚠️ Stability of the vehicle

Tips:

- ✓ Turn on your headlights
- ✓ Do not drive in a dust storm - pull over at a safe location until it has passed
- ✓ Watch out for sand accumulation
- ✓ Hold steering wheel firmly
