Driving condition:

FOG

Risk:

! Visibility is reduced

! Other drivers' visibility is reduced

Tips:



Don't drive in fog

If you encounter fog on a journey, slow down, turn on front and rear fog lights and pull over at a safe location

Be aware – other drivers may not see you

V Use the horn if necessary

Driving condition:

RAIN

Risk:

- Visibility is reduced
- **!** Stopping distance increases
- **!** Wadis forming

Tips:





Aquaplaning (tyres not making contact with the road)

vehicle ahead (minimum 6 seconds)

If visibility is poor, pull over at a safe location

V Before a journey, check your tyres & wiper blades









Driving condition:

WIND

Risk:

- ! Dust
- Sand accumulation
- Stability of the vehicle

Tips:

- Turn on your headlights
- **V** Do not drive in a dust storm pull over at a safe location until it has passed
- ✓ Watch out for sand accumulation
- Hold steering wheel firmly
